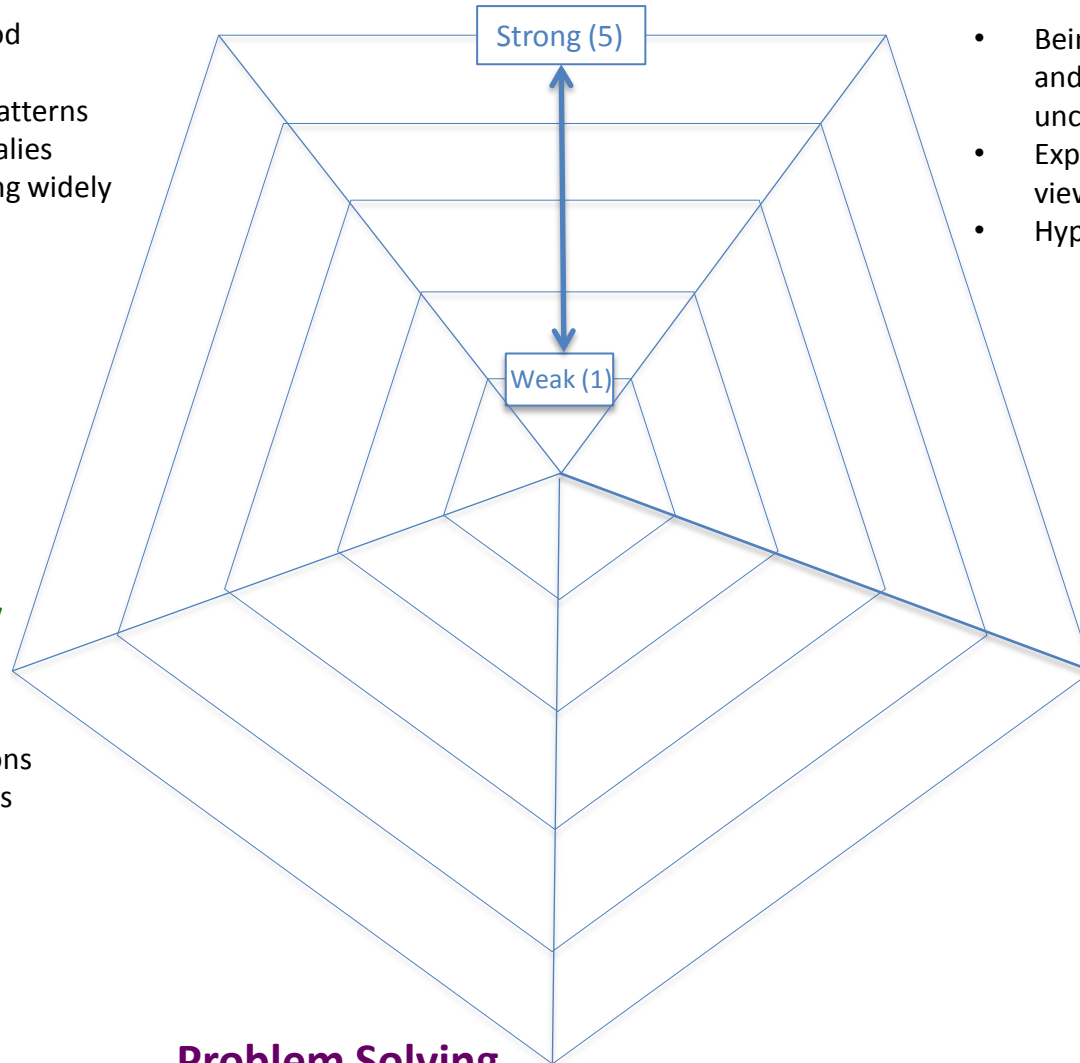


Curiosity
